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ABOUT THE CLINICIAN

Gene Leiser, CJF

Gene has been shoeing horses for 24 years, starting at the age of 24 shoeing a wide variety of horses. His first shoeing contest was in 1999 where he won Division 1 High Point, becoming hooked on competing. Competing has given him the opportunity to travel and meet some of the best horseshoers and craftsmen in the world.

In 2008 and 2009 he was on the American Farriers Team, competing at the World Champion Blacksmiths (WCB) Competition in Calgary, Canada and the International Team Shoeing Contest in England.

Gene was the 2010 and 2012 AFA National Champion and WCB 2010 National Champion, competing on the WCB 2011 team. He has competed at the WCB Competition in Calgary five times, making the Top Ten, three times and Top Five, one time. Gene has also competed at the World Horseshoeing Classic seven times with his esteemed teammates, winning twice and placing second, four times.

Gene believes very strongly in skill and craftsmanship in the trade of horseshoeing developed over years of practice and application. The horseshoeing industry is filled with information and theories, all of which is irrelevant if the skill has not been developed to apply it. Gene has been helped along the way by many great individuals and enjoys giving back at clinics and judging horseshoeing contests.

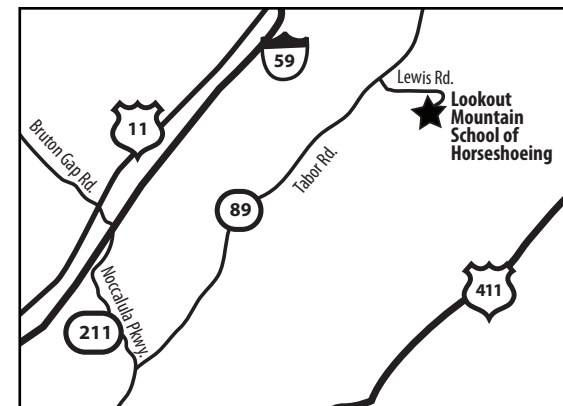

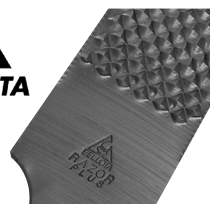
