In addition to his appearances on the AFT, Jim has been a two time National Champion in 2-man Draft Shoeing, four-time National Champion in Hunter Shoeing, a fifteen-time Top Ten Finalist at the World Champion Blacksmith Competition, three-time member of World Champion 4-man draft shoeing team, 2003 North American Challenge Cup Champion, 2005 National High-Point Champion and received the Jim Linzy Outstanding Clinician award in 2006.

Jim considers it a great honor to be appointed by his peers as a Judge for the World Championship Blacksmiths' Competition in Calgary, the International Championships in Stoneleigh, England, the Canadian Championships in Calgary, and the North American Challenge Cup in 2000 and in 2013.

A past president of the Rocky Mountain Farrier's Association, Jim has a strong commitment to the farrier industry and has served the American Farrier's Association as a member of the Rules Committee, the Certification Committee and the Education Committee.
