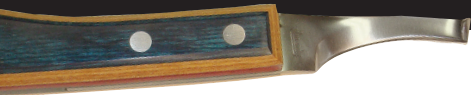

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Tips for using a FootPro™ diamond sharpener

The FootPro™ diamond sharpener is designed to keep a knife sharp – not to sharpen a very dull knife. The diamond particles remove very fine amounts of steel from the blade; therefore, it would take too long to put an edge on a dull knife. Dirt, sand and rocks easily dull a hoof knife. These materials can be found in the bottom of the hoof. Regular use of the diamond sharpener only takes a few seconds and reduces the time you will need to spend with grinders and buffers. Use the sharpener often, rather than waiting until the knife is dull. A touch up between horses works well.

The sharpener should be used cutting toward the edge of the blade rather than away from it. (See image #1). When using a dry sharpener, the fine cuttings from the knife blade will fill between the diamond particles, causing you to think the sharpener is worn. Brushing with detergent, warm water and a stiff bristle brush will clean the debris and restore the sharpener. (See image #2). Using water to keep the sharpener wet during the sharpening process helps extend the life of the sharpener. Dipping it in water as you go, will help to keep it clean. (See image #3).
