Tom Petersen, CJF began his shoeing career at Montana State University's Horseshoeing Program, in the Spring of 2005, under the instruction of Tom Wolfe. After completing the program, Tom apprenticed under multiple farriers in the Gallatin Valley, surrounding Bozeman, for 2-1/2 years. Following his apprenticeship, Tom established a successful business in the Gallatin Valley, shoeing many disciplines including; rodeo, ranch, jumping and dressage horses.

In 2010, Tom completed his CJF with the American Farriers Association. In 2011, Tom went to his first competition and was hooked. He earned a spot on the World Championship Blacksmiths (WCB) Team and maintained it from 2015 to 2019. In 2016 and 2018, Tom won the WCB National Championship title. In 2018, Tom also won the very prestigious World Horseshoeing Classic with the WCB Team. In the Spring of 2019, Tom won the AFA's National Championship and the Australasian Champion at the EKKA Competition in Brisbane, Australia. Tom has been a clinician and judged farrier events in and out of the states. Tom is humbled and excited to share his knowledge and experience with others in the industry.

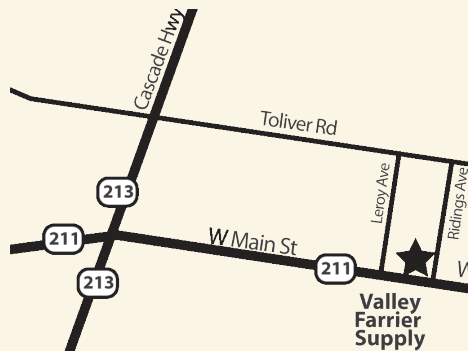

This 3/8" thick generic shape shoe uses a high grade steel and good carbon content for extended wear. The Kerckhaert Dura Plain meets the needs of horses working in rough terrains. The shoe is available in a symmetrical shape with no front and hind.



KERCKHAERT HALFROUND

The Half Round is plain stamped with no crease and is available in two stock sizes, 9/16" and 5/8". This shoe provides excellent breakover.

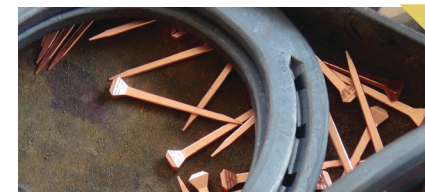
KERCKHAERT DF SERIES

The DF series of shoes is a European line of shoes. The DF line offers the broadest selection in features such as fronts and hinds, left and right foot patterns, different web sizes, clip positioning and nail hole sizing according to the size of the shoe.



BELLOTA PRIME LEVEL RASP

The Prime Level complements the Top Level rasp, 12% wider and 10% thinner than regular rasps, for perfect leveling balance and control. This rasp features a Chip Breaker style file side for smoothest finish.



LIBERTY COMBO SLIM NAILS

Combo nails are a modification of the City or Slim nail. The heads are slightly larger but yet the shank is still similar to the City or Slim. They are often used for resetting when nail holes have enlarged or with shoes that have a wide crease.



BELLOTA TOP LEVEL RASP

The Top Level is 12% wider and 10% thinner than regular rasps, for perfect leveling balance and control. The 8 tooth rasp side pattern has an aggressive cut and an intermediate file side, similar to the Top Sharp.
