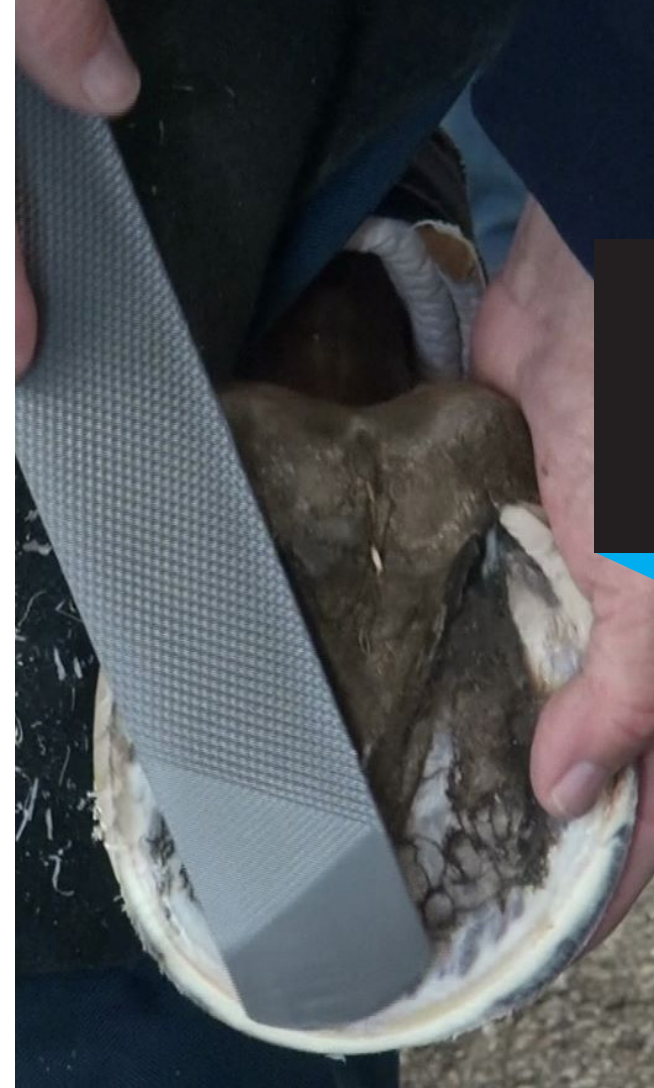

WITH STEVE STANLEY, APF

Steve Stanley started working with his father Dave Stanley in 1974, shoeing Standardbred racehorses in New Hampshire. He came to KY in 1975 with his Dad. Steve shod horses at the Horse Park with his Dad while he was an instructor at the vocational school there. He started shoeing on his own in 1979 when he opened a shop at the Red Mile after graduating high school. Steve has shod 26 Divisional Horse of the Year winners (3 all age HOY), 31 millionaire racehorses, and 20 World Champions (some of those multiple WR holders). He continues to operate a shop at the Red Mile as well as working on a number of Thoroughbred farms in the Lexington, KY area.

Steve has spoken at the International Hoof-Care Summit and been awarded outstanding speaker of the conference multiple times. He writes a horseshoeing column for Hoofbeats Magazine. Steve has been a member of the AFA and Bluegrass Associations and currently is living in Versailles, KY.
